MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT TIME HERE AGAIN: 10/15/24 - 12/07/24

For those of us already on Medicare, it is the time of year to review our Medicare supplemental plans, whether a prescription drug or an advantage plan. Remember, no matter how happy you are this year with your present plan, these plans change every year, sometimes significantly. Our individual needs also often change. It is smart to reassess your Medicare plan choices every year to assure you have the "best fit" for **YOU** next year.

An easy way to do this is to make an appointment at the Area Agency on Aging (717-273-9262). Trained volunteers can review with you **ALL** the plans available in our area, not just the 2 or 3 offered by any one company/agent. **YOU** can then choose which fits **YOUR** needs best. If that ends up being your present plan, you are finished. However, if a change is called for, the volunteers can enroll you through Medicare in your new plan right there and then. It is always your choice. For those who prefer to do this themselves, the Medicare.gov website has a very good plan finder tool which provides unbiased data on **ALL** the plans available, not just the ones from a specific company. A word of caution: if you do this, dig down to the details — i.e., words like "Deductible" have unusual meanings here.

Finally, a note to our younger residents who have just started on Medicare or will soon be going on it: The Area Agency on Aging has a monthly seminar that covers the basics of Medicare Parts A and B, and they discuss the choices between Medigap or Medicare Advantage plans. Individual appointments to help you make your choices and pick your plans are also available, and encouraged, all year. Please realize, some of the choices you make now can limit your ability to change your mind later if your health situation changes.

PURPOSE OF LAKEVIEW CENTER RESIDENT COMMITTEE AND DUTIES OF RESIDENT COMMITTEE MEMBERS (from Lakeview Center Bylaws)

Purpose of Lakeview Center Resident Committee

To provide for the administration of social functions for the Arbor Gate community residents.

Duties of Resident Committee Members (Lakeview Center Bylaws)

CHAIRPERSON:

- Acts as liaison between residents and Hometown America for matters within the purpose of the Resident Committee cited above.
- Conducts all meetings.
- Assures that decisions made by the Resident Committee and at Residents Meetings are implemented.

VICE-CHAIRPERSON

- Assumes duties of Chairperson if Chairperson is absent.
- Automatically replaces Chairperson if position becomes vacant.
- Maintains bulletin board and activity calendars in Lakeview Center.
- Clears all requests for use of Lakeview Center, maintains master calendar.

SECRETARY

- Records minutes of all Resident Committee and Residents Meetings.
- Keeps official minutes for historical purposes.
- Distributes minutes to Resident Committee members.
- Posts prior month Residents Meeting Minutes in Lakeview Center.

TREASURER

- Responsible for receipt and disbursement of all funds.
- Presents monthly statements of financial transactions and account balance at monthly Residents Meeting.
- Posts copy of prior month Treasurer's Report in Lakeview Center.
- Deposits funds received and writes checks as necessary. Checks must be signed by any two of the following: Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer.
- Assists in annual audit of Resident Committee financial records.

LIAISONS (total of 3)

- Acts as representative to the Board for their assigned committees.
- Maintains contact with assigned committee chairpersons and reports any pertinent information to the Resident Committee.

PLEASE NOTE: The assignments listed above can be reallocated among the liaisons, and assignments can be added or subtracted as conditions warrant.

A NOTE ON ELECTIONS: Individuals are elected by the residents to serve on the Resident Committee; they are **NOT** elected to a specific position. After the elections are completed, the Resident Committee meets to assign the positions for the following year.

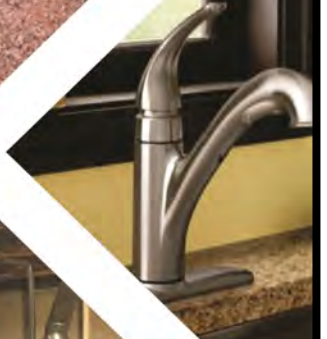

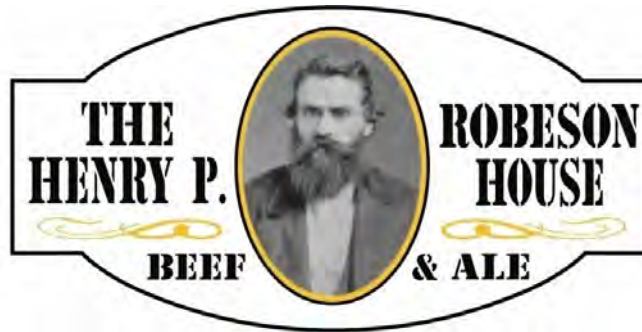
