ANNUAL MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT

WHO CARES? We all should care, especially those of us already enrolled in Medicare whether we have a prescription drug plan or a Medicare Advantage plan. Please realize that every year the plans change, sometimes subtly, sometimes drastically. Also, our needs change, whether a new condition, or simply a change in medications.

Through the years, we've saved a lot of people money by finding plans that better match their needs. We also find many people whose present plan is their best match. Either way, you know you have the optimum plan for YOU. There is no "Best" plan, only what fits YOUR individual needs best.

As in past years, the County Area on Aging Agency offers individual appointments to help people with their unique medical insurance needs. For an appointment please call **717-273-9262**.

If you prefer to do it yourself, the plan finder tool on the **Medicare.gov** website is a great resource.

Just remember the volunteers at the Agency and the Medicare website will give you unbiased information on ALL the plans available in this area, not just the 2 or 3 offered by any single Agent or company.

For those who will soon be going on Medicare, I urge you to make an appointment before you make your choice. The options are confusing, the sales pitches are enticing, and the initial choices can have lifelong impacts. You generally only get one "Initial Enrollment Period" when you cannot be turned down by any plan. Remember, this is just the start of the next phase of your life. You need to plan for the future as well as today.

Unlike the annual Open Enrollment period, appointments for people new to Medicare can be made any time of the year that you become eligible for Medicare, preferably several months before. The phone number is the same, 717-273-9262.

- Please place trash and recycling curbside the night before your pick up day.
- We do not accept appliances, building materials, brick, stone, cement, gas grill tanks, batteries, paints, or hazardous waste.
- There is a trash limit of three 32-gallon bags or cans each week.
- For a construction roll-off dumpster or bulk item pick-up please call our office at 717-949-2363.
- We observe the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. Service falling on these holidays will be delayed by one day for the rest of the week.

Only the **Big 4** should be placed in your recycling bin: 1) corrugated cardboard, 2) plastic bottles and jugs with a neck, 3) metal food and beverage cans and 4) glass bottles and jars. Everything else does not belong in your recycling bin.

1. Thursdays will be the day leaves get picked up this year. For new residents and a refresher for existing residents, please do the following: rake leaves into the street against the curb. Do not put sticks or branches in the piles, only leaves. The first pick up will be October 30. Subsequent pickups will be on the November 6, 13, and 20 if needed.
2. Yard Waste dumpster: Please do not put flowerpots or bags in the yard waste dumpster. Take them home and put them in your trash. When in doubt as to what to put in yard waste dumpster, call the office at 717-866-9363.
3. Please do not put your old salt, cardboard, or anything at the shop without talking to Butch at 717-454-8517. He will approve what you can leave for him to use.
4. Christmas cards! For newer residents – the mail unit will be placed in the Center outside the Activities Room on the way to the Coffee Shop on December 2. You may put your cards for Arbor Gate residents in the alphabetical compartments. Remember to check the unit to see if you received any cards.
5. Vaccine Clinic is Monday November 10 starting at 9 AM at the Center LL. Pick up a form in the Activities Room. Fill it and hand it in to me prior to November 10 to obtain an appointment.
6. Hometown America purchased two sets of corn hole games for use at the Community Building. Gather your friends and have a fun playing a game indoors in the Banquet Room. The games are stored in the Craft Room.
7. Deliveries are lately being left at the Rt. 422 gated entrance. If you see packages there, either bring them to the office, or be kind to the person who was to receive them and deliver them directly to them.
8. If you are having something delivered or a contractor is coming to do work at your home, please make them aware that they must come into the community off of Kercher Avenue. They cannot get in the Rt. 422 gated entrance unless you meet them there and you have a transponder so you can let them in. The office does not have a button to push to open the gate.

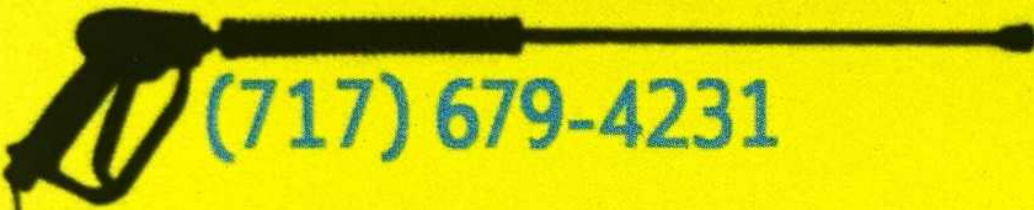
