Marilyn's Monthly Missive

1. Please do not change the temperature setting on the freezer in the kitchen.
2. At the yard waste dumpster, if you drop anything on the platform, please clean it up. If you need a pitchfork, there is one on the platform.
3. Please keep your emergency contacts updated with the office. If I do not have current names and numbers, I will not be able to contact someone if I need to.
4. Please remember you are allowed one small garden flag in your front flower bed.
5. SLOW down when going to the yard waste dumpster. When your speed is too fast while turning the corner, dust and stones are thrown about. This damages Butch's truck and creates work for him to repair driveway surface stones and avoid a muddy mess. Please be kind to Butch; he has enough to do.
6. Please be sure to put your cans away and se-

cure the lid when they are at the curb for collection, so the high winds do not blow trash around the community. This is becoming a problem.

7. If the trash collectors happen to miss picking up your can, please make sure to let me know. Do not leave your can out till the following week.

8. If you are having work done on your home and your contractor puts a dumpster on the street, they must put cones around it - front, back, and side facing the street.

If cones are not placed and there is an accident because a driver could not see the dumpster at night or in blinding sun, it will be deemed to be the contractor's fault.

Residents having work done are responsible for relaying to the contractor that cones are required and confirming that they are placed when the dumpster arrives.

From the Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority

When in doubt, throw it out!

The most common misunderstanding the public has about Curbside Recycling is that you need to put as much as possible into your recycle bin. However, recycling is actually a system of collecting and processing used material that still has value. This means NOT everything is recyclable. There must be someone to buy the used material and recycle it into a new product. Just because it has a recycling symbol on the bottom, does NOT mean it is a recyclable! While most of us are well-intentioned, when we put materials that don't belong into the bin, we are actually contaminating the recycling stream. When you don't recycle right, this negatively impacts our environment and economy.

The following are the CORE materials that can be recycled if you participate in a Curbside recycling program in Lebanon County:

- Plastic Bottles & Jugs ONLY (Check the neck)
- Metal Food & Beverage Cans (Aluminum & Steel)
- Glass Bottles & Jars (Clear, Green, Brown)
- Newspaper (Dry)
- Corrugated Cardboard (Clean, Dry & Must Be Flat)

Remember ONLY these core acceptable materials can be recycled at the curb! Everything else should be put in the trash. If you aren't sure, just remember this simple phrase...

“When in doubt, throw it out!”

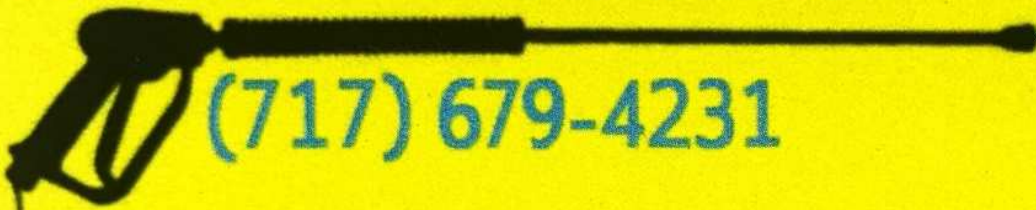
